Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) Emergency Groundwater Transfers:

Support ADWR's annual legislation to allow groundwater to be transported away from a groundwater basin that is outside an active management area under specific emergency circumstances and on a temporary basis.

Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) Budget/Fees/Rulemaking:

Support ADWR in its efforts to adequately serve Arizona on water issues.

Arizona Water Banking Authority (AWBA) Funding:

Support the AWBA's efforts to meet its intended functions and protect its funds.

Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) Fees/Rulemaking:

Monitor the ADEQ rulemaking processes in regard to water quality permitting fees for aquifer protection and reclaimed water permitting programs and to establish fees for the Arizona Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (AZPDES) permit program.

Multiple Species Conservation Program (MSCP) Funding:

Support the Arizona Game and Fish Department's efforts to collect and maintain revenues sufficient to continue its annual contribution toward the costs of the MSCP.

Water Resources Development Commission:

Participate in and monitor the activities of the Water Resources Development Commission. The Commission will be evaluating water supplies currently available throughout the State and identifying water supplies to meet additional demands in the next 25, 50 and 100 years.

State Agency Fee Commission:

Monitor the activities of the State Agency Fee Commission, which will be reviewing agency fiscal needs, appropriate fee levels and fee authority.
