ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE POLICY

POLICY

The Environmental Compliance Policy of the Central Arizona Water Conservation District (“CAWCD”) is to comply with all applicable environmental laws and regulations, to cooperate with all agencies and authorities having jurisdiction over matters of environmental compliance, and to promote protection of the environment. In fulfillment of this policy, CAWCD will establish procedures and practices concerning compliance with applicable environmental laws.

PROVISIONS

The General Manager is delegated the primary responsibility and authority for assuring CAWCD’s compliance with environmental laws. The General Manager may further delegate responsibility for environmental compliance as he deems appropriate. In carrying out this responsibility, the General Manager may, at his discretion, establish an Environmental Compliance Committee, designate a Chairman of the Committee, and be an ex-officio member thereof. The Committee may be composed of management and employees with environmental responsibilities, including the General Counsel of CAWCD and such others as the General Manager may deem appropriate. Not less than annually a report on environmental compliance shall be made to the Board of Directors. At the direction of the General Manager, the General Counsel to the District is to create and maintain such confidential files on Environmental Compliance as are necessary to appropriately implement this policy and to assure employees of such confidentiality as may be permitted by law in the appropriate circumstances while assuring CAWCD of environmental compliance.

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
